

### Dressing Rooms + Backstage Layout

PPAC is equipped with the following rooms located on the stage level of the building:

- 4 Star Dressing Rooms, equipped with private bath and shower, makeup mirror with lights, a comfortable couch, and mini-refrigerator. Star rooms typically accommodate two (2) to three (3) performers. Dressing room three is handicap accessible.
- 4 Principal Dressing Rooms equipped with private bath and shower, makeup mirrors with lights. Principal rooms typically accommodate four (4) performers comfortably, with the option to fit a fifth.
- 2 Chorus Rooms, located at the sub-stage level. Each chorus room has space for up to fifteen (15) performers and are equipped with bath and shower facilities, makeup counters, and mirrors with lights.
- Wardrobe room is located at the sub-stage level and is equipped with three (3) washers and (3) dryers.
- Production office, company management office, and green room are all located backstage left at stage level. The production office and company management office are equipped with tables, desks, and chairs, respectively, as well as dedicated hardline ports for tour routers.
- All dressing rooms, offices, and performer hallways are equipped with paging systems and show feed.






- There is the ability to park either one (1) 53' trailer or one (1) Bus on the SL Loading Pad.







# PROVIDENCE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER - PROVIDENCE, RI PIT DIMENSIONS
