





Family Restrooms: 2 private restrooms available off to right of Grand Lobby. A converted family restroom off to right of Grand Lobby and upstairs on 1B.

Break Area (Quiet and Activity Area): Lobby Lounge off to left of Grand Lobby. Upstairs on 1B across from family restroom.

Standing Room: Rows PP - RR on Orchestra Left and Right.

Sensory Packets: Available at theatre doors.

Assisted listening devices are available on a first come; first-served basis in the Grand Lobby across from the **Aisle 5** entrance. A driver's license or valid ID will be requested as a deposit.

Character Cards are provided at entry.

To accommodate dietary restrictions, **snacks from home are permitted**; however, we encourage you to limit your eating to outside the theatre or in lobby areas before the show.

Photography, audio and/or video recording is NOT PERMITTED inside the theatre.

Slight adjustments have been made to the lighting and sound of the show. House lights in the theatre will be dimmed but left on at approximately 30%. Noise levels will be capped at approximately 90 decibels.
